**2. Background:**

When the PNP Region 11 Command Conference was held in Tagum, Davao on 12<sup>th</sup> day March 1996 it was presided by no less than the Dir. General of the RECAREDO A. SARMIENTO III. Reports information and data gathered constituted part of the GHQ evaluation of the region. On that occasion, the Regional Director had noticed some shortcomings in the Command prompting him to initiate innovations in the field of Police Service. Out of his observations, he had identified the following deficiencies in Regional Command as follows:

A. **Operation wise**, Recom 11 cannot compete with some of the progressive regions in terms of crime solutions due to the minimal existence of criminalities in the AOR;

B. **Intelligence wise**, although sightings of bad elements had been filtered and monitored, limitations of the PNP operational jurisdiction hampers the numerous opportunities to score accomplishments.

C. **Achievement wise**, Recom 11 garnered numerous honors and merits for having the best Provincial Command and the Best Police Station nationwide last CY 1995. However it was found out that in totality, the Command is far behind.

Nevertheless, a Command with this predicament has still the chance to enhance its performance leading to the full magnification of the PNP's goals with impetus on the PNP Mission and Vision. It is there that concentration of utmost consideration can be developed and upgraded if properly and vigorously pursued and complied.

Hence, the insistence that a special initiative be undertaken that will gain optimum accomplishment on the PNP's objectives firmly hinging on a triple-task of combining Operations, Intelligence and the PCR that if strategically planned and carried out, it will serve best as contributing factors in the realization of the PNP Mission and Vision.

**SPECIAL PROJECT:**

As pointed out by the PNP Regional Director Recom 11, the motorcycle riding people can be one among the best in the community to be organized and mobilized because its membership come from different sectors of the community. Accordingly, a regional civic organization can be realized with the DNPPC as the pilot of the project, subject to be expanded region-wide, if not nationwide.

Thereafter, the **KABABAYAN RIDERS ASSOCIATION FOR A NEW CULTURAL HARMONY AND ORDER** was organized commonly known now as the “**KARANCHO**” as its acronym.

### **3. Purpose and Objectives:**

This special Project provides the concept, guidelines and task for the conduct of organizing KARANCHO for the attainment of the following broad and specific objectives.

#### **( A ) Broad Objective:**

To enable the PNP Regional Command to be competitive in the nationwide effort of attaining the PNP Mission and Vision by way of developing Institutional Support through direct involvement of the targeted institutions to undertake very special work programs that will capture the interest of the majority and one that will endure.

#### **(B) Specific Objective:**

To urge and encourage all PNP provincial Command under the jurisdiction of Recom 11 to organize KARANCHO to support the Command in the effective enhancement of the PNP Image Credibility designed to attain regional and ultimately national prominence.

### **4. Concepts:**

#### **A. General:**

Comparatively, the **KARANCHO** was comprehensively and dynamically designed as the best and most competent conduit in effectuating the PNP Mission and Vision towards the goal of attaining the trust and confidence of the public in supporting actively and responsively the PNP. Likewise, on the part of PNP officers and Members, its thrust is for internal reforms that upon organizing the said group, without them knowing that they are already committed to regional civic organization whose objective is to restore our Filipino values and superfluous virtues towards the attainment of cultural harmony and order. By living up and committing oneself even only to the organization's “**CREDO**” of “**Respect One Another**” other values will be added to him like respect, humility, brotherhood, camaraderie leading to his deep immersion and involvement in activities on public service and on the nationalistic heritage of a tangible maintenance of peace and order.

#### **B. Concept of Operations:**

1. Widening of Community Relations
2. Community Organization and Mobilization
3. Institutional Intelligence Network
4. Community Involvement on Crime awareness and Prevention
5. Public Service
6. External and Internal Economic Development
7. Counter-Insurgency

#### **B-1. Rationale**

**B-1-1. Widening of Community Relations** – persons not having actual and personal

meetings or being introduced to each other will remain strangers, or even aloof and detached from one another. But if these people will meet during occasions with lofty and equitable cause over a continuing program or activity, they will be obviously acquainted with each other and be sealed with lasting friendship. In the KARANCHO, friendship can be extensively established by inviting and recruiting friends from all walks of life to join the cause of the organization using the multiplying principle of a “a friend inviting his friends” and by such avenue, the magnitude of friendship will grow and the number of friends will multiply.

B-1-2. **Community Organization and Mobilization** - because KARANCHO was designed to welcome anybody from all walks of life or from the different sector of the community, the PNP can easily organize the community it being a civic organization and can be mobilized to get involved in civic-oriented programs. It also follows that mobilization by the PNP of this community can aptly be realized since it was founded and organized by the PNP, thus giving the PNP access and manageability in supervising its mobilization especially in the maintenance of peace and order.

B-1-3. **Institutional Intelligence Network** - the by-word of the PNP Operatives that “we need a thief to catch a thief” as an art of Intelligence is not acceptable by the community for it leads the PNP to be often misconstrued to be conniving with these bad and undesirable elements. With this institution (KARANCHO), the network of the PNP Intelligence will also be strengthened, as it will have a network for information from the underworld and an intelligence network within the institution with proper orientation and a tie-up with responsive and active community.

B-1-4. **Community Involvement on Crime Awareness Prevention** – with the existence of such sphere of trust and influence of every individual in the KARANCHO, one will not even realize that he is already assuming and actively playing the role of a “KAUBAN” of the PNP in pursuing crime prevention and other allied Police works and activities and at the same time supplementing fastest but lightest means of mobility and manpower.

B-1-5. **Public Service** - Every person has that instinct of concern to help the needy in time of distress, but it has been the past experience of many that while in the act of following the said natural impulse to help, he is driven out for being unauthorized. These instances often occur during earthquakes, conflagrations, traffic mishaps, inundations and other disasters and calamities. In order not to be in such humiliating state and dilemma, the answer is “Mag KARANCHO tayo upang maging autorisado” because KARANCHO members are representing the different segments of the community. It is not therefore remote in the future when a public service program and activity undertaken by KARANCHO becomes a trustworthy endeavor of the entire KARANCHO community.

B. **Survey** - Shall be conducted in the manner of information gathering from the supporting institutions pertaining to the community feedback towards KARANCHO in the locality.

C. **Morale and Welfare** - There shall be an annual recognition day in which nominees for an outstanding KARANCHO of the Year to be recommended by respective KARANCHO Chapter which is subject for evaluation by the Supporting Institution through the endorsement of the KARANCHO Regional Office for probable nomination as a National Honoree whenever possible.

## **Articles of Incorporation**

### **KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS;**

We the undersigned incorporators, all of legal age and a majority of whom are residents of the Philippines, have this day voluntarily agreed to form a non-stock corporation under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

### **AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:**

**First:** That the name of the said association shall be:

KABABAYAN RIDERS ASSOCIATION FOR A NEW CULTURAL HARMONY AND ORDER, INC.  
(KARANCHO, INC.)

**Second:** That the purpose or purposes for which such corporation is incorporated are:

It aims for the restoration of our Filipino culture and the development of our moral and spiritual values as the key for the promotion of harmony among men. It will strive to achieve where the other groups had failed in restoring some of those values, respect, compassion and humility are some of our precious and vital values seldom, heard of and practiced nowadays, Herewith are the other objectives of the association;

1. To primarily promote love, respect, brotherhood, unity, awareness, harmony, humility and understanding and of mutual assistance in pursuing, promoting and protecting the common and individual rights, benefits, welfare and interests of the association and its individual members as well as the community;
2. To develop the “KARANCHO OR KAUBAN” concept into an institution of lofty and concern citizens that can be depended upon during times of distress and utmost needs;
3. To be an effective conduit of the government and the private sectors and NGO’S in carrying our assistance projects and programs designed to promote and uplift the general welfare and interest of the community;
4. To conduct fellowship of members for familiarization and socials, motorcycle fun/joy riding and other allied activities to establish genuine brotherhood and coherence among members;
5. To assist as an auxiliary force in promoting various government programs and networking services considering this as a formidable group with multi-sectoral membership equipped with the needed capability to effectively perform and function;
6. With GOD’S help, it will assume its nationalistic heritage in whatever manner and for whatever task it may be requested to and assigned by duly constituted authorities and top leaders in promoting, securing and preserving the peace and order of Davao in particular and the country in general, as well as the restoration of our moral values, preservation of our superfluous virtues and the revival of our Filipino cultural beliefs.

By Laws

KABABAYAN RIDERS ASSOCIATION FOR A NEW CULTUURAL  
HARMONY AND ORDER, INCORPORATED  
( KARANCHO )

Section 1. ANNUAL MEETINGS - The annual meetings of the members shall be held at the principal office of the association on LAST SUNDAY OF JANUARY of each year.

Section 2. BI-ANNUAL METTINGS- All KARANCHO Chapter Chairmen shall conduct Provincial Assessment meeting twice a year every last Friday till Sunday night of the months of February and August.

Section 3. MONTHLY SPECIAL MEETINGS - Monthly / Special meetings of the members shall be called every end of the month by President of the Association. During such meetings, the President shall render his monthly report to the members regarding the activities of the association.

Special meetings may be called as the need arises by the Board of Trustees, the President or

upon petition of 1/3 of the general membership.

Section 3. NOTICES – Notices of the date, time and place of annual monthly and special meeting shall be given either personally or by special delivery mail, and should be posted in the Bulletin Board, at least one week before the date set for such meeting. In urgent cases, the notice may be communicated at least two days before the meeting in person, by telephone or by telegram. The notice of every special meeting shall state briefly the purpose or purposes of the meeting. No other business shall be considered at such meeting, except with the consent of all the members present.

Section 4. WAIVER– waiver in behalf of the concerned person shall be executed in designating proxy.

Section 5. QUORUM - A quorum for any meeting shall consists of a majority of the members and a majority of such quorum may decide any question at the meeting, except those matters where the Corporation Code requires the affirmative vote of a greater proportion.

Section 6. ORDER OF BUSINESS- The order of business at the Annual Meeting of the members shall be as follows: Proof of Service of the required notice of the meeting, except when such notice is waived by the members constituting a quorum.

- a. Proof of the presence of a quorum.
- b. Reading and approval of the minutes of the previous annual meeting, except when such reading is dispensed with a majority vote of those presents.
- c. Unfinished business.
- d. Report of the President.
- e. Election of the Trustees for the ensuing year.
- f. Other matters.

The order of business at any meeting may be changed by a vote of a majority of the members present.

Section 7. VOTING PROXY – members shall be entitled to one vote, and they may be vote either in person or by proxy, which shall be in writing and filed with the Secretary of the Association before the scheduled meeting.

## ARTICLE II TRUSTEES

Section 1. BOARD OF TRUSTEES - The corporate powers of the Association shall be exercised, its business conducted and its property controlled by the Board of Trustees.

Section 2. QUALIFICATIONS – no members shall be eligible for the election to the Board of Trustees unless he has the following qualifications:

1. A member must be a Filipino citizen and of legal age.
2. A member must be in good moral character.
3. Must be in good standing

Section 3. DISQUALIFICATION OF DIRECTORS, TRUSTEES OR OFFICERS.- No member convicted by final judgment of an offense punishable by imprisonment for a period exceeding six (6) years, or a violation of this code, committed within five (5) years prior to the date of election or appointment shall qualify as a trustees or officer and having conflicting interest with the activities of the association.

## ARTICLE III OFFICERS

Section 1. OFFICERS - The officers of the Association shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary, a Treasurer and an Auditor, PRO and Sergeant at Arms. They shall be elected by the Board of Trustees from among themselves. The Board may combine compatible offices in a single person.,

Section 2. TERM OF OFFICE OF OFFICERS - All Officers of the Association shall hold office for two (2) year during its first foundation wherein after two years transition period shall conduct election yearly.

## ARTICLE IV

### FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF OFFICERS

Section 1. PRESIDENT - The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Association. In addition to duties as such, he shall at all time ready to report the state of the organization upon call of the Board of Trustees, General Assembly and or Special/Emergency meeting.

He shall execute all resolution and/or decisions of the Board of Trustees. He shall be charged with directing and overseeing the activities of the Association. He shall appoint and have control over all employees of the association, review and approve expense vouchers. Together with the Secretary of the Association, he shall present to the Board of Trustees and the members an Annual Budget and from time to time as may be necessary, supplemental budgets. He shall submit to the Board of Trustees as soon as possible after the close of each fiscal year, and to the members of each annual meeting, a complete report of the activities and operations of the Association for the fiscal year under his term.

Section 2. VICE PRESIDENT- The Vice-President if qualified, shall exercise all powers and perform all duties of the President during the absence or incapacity of the latter and shall perform duties that may be assigned by the Board of Trustees.

Section 3. SECRETARY GENERAL - The Secretary must be a citizen and resident of the Philippines and shall give all the notices required by these by laws and keep the minutes of all meetings of the members of the Board of Trustees and of all meetings of the members and of the Board of Trustees and of all meetings of all Committees in a book kept for the purpose. He shall keep the seal of the corporation and affix such seal to any paper or instruments requiring the same. He shall have custody of the correspondence files and all other papers that are to be kept by the Treasurer. He shall maintain the list of registered members have charge of the bulletin board at the principal office of the association. He shall also perform all such other duties and work as the Board of Trustees may from time to time assign to him.

Section 4. TREASURER - The Treasurer shall have charge of the fund, receipt and disbursements of the association. He shall keep all moneys and other valuables of the association in such bank or banks as the Board of Trustees may designate. He shall keep and have charge of the Book of Accounts which shall be open for inspection by any member of the Board of Trustees, whenever required, an account of financial conditions of the association and of all transactions made up by him as Treasurer. He shall also perform such other duties and functions as may be assigned to him from time to time by the Board of Trustees. He shall post a bond in such amount as may be fixed by the Board of Trustees.

Section 5. AUDITOR - He shall examine financial records and audit money. He shall also perform other functions as may be provided by the Board of Trustees.

## ARTICLE V

### MEMBERS

Section 1. QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP - The Board shall determine the qualifications of an applicant for membership.

Section 2. RIGHTS OF MEMBERS - A member shall have the following rights:

- a. To exercise the rights to vote on all matters relating to the affairs of the association for as long as he is in good standing status.
- b. To be eligible to any elective or appointive office of the association
- c. To participate in all deliberation /meeting of the association.
- d. To avail of all the facilities of the association.

- e. To examine all records or books of the association during business hours.

Section 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE MEMBERS - A member shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. To obey and comply with the By-Laws, rules and regulations that may be promulgated by the association from time –to-time
- b. To attend all meetings that may be called by the Board of Trustees.
- c. To pay membership dues and other assessments of the association.
- d. To promote the aims and purposes of the association, the success of its organization, welfare of its members and the association as a whole.

## ARTICLE VI SUSPENSION, EXPULSION AND TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Suspension, expulsion and termination of membership, shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the association and of the corporation code of the Philippines.

Any member of the association may file charges against a member by filing a written complaint with the Secretary of the Association. The Board of Trustees shall call a special meeting of the members to consider the charges. The affirmative vote of 1/3 of all the members of the association shall be necessary to suspend a member; provided that if the penalty is expulsion, the affirmative vote of 2/3 of all the members in the chapter shall be necessary to expel a member.

Any member may be suspended, expelled or terminated from the association for acts, inimical, prejudicial or contrary to the rights, welfare and interest of the association and/or any of its members.

a) The specific act and surrounding circumstances shall be reflected in a written complaint by any member or non-member to be submitted to the Secretary or the Committee on Investigation and Disciplinary Action which shall function and act upon said complaint strictly in accordance with the due process of law.

b) The extent of the irregularity done or the gravity of the offense committed will be the basis of the Committee's action on the complaint, with rebuke or reprimand as the lightest action.

c) Any member meted out with the penalty of expulsion or termination automatically loses his rights and benefits of membership; and all dues and fees paid by him shall be forfeited in favor of the association. The subject will be required to turn over his KARANCHO uniform, and flag to the President.

d) In the event that a chapter or zone suffers an erosion of members, rampant of non feasance, misfeasance and malfeasance grossly violating the concept and objectives of the association and inimical to its integrity, the KARANCHO officialdom of the umbrella organization will have the option to cause for the disbanding of that chapter or zone, and to cause for the confiscation of all KARANCHO uniforms and other related and identifying materials from all the members of that unit, thus, finishing the ultimate act of dissolving it.

## ARTICLE VII FUND

Section 1. FUNDS – the funds of the association shall be derived from admission/membership fees, annual/monthly dues and special assessments of members, gifts, donations or benefits.

Section 2. FEES AND DUES - Every member of the association shall in addition to the membership fee, dues and/or assessments, special shall be supported that may imposed by the association from time to time.

**Second:** That the purpose or purposes for which such corporation is incorporated are:

A. Broad Objective:

To support all KARANCHO chapters being challenged to establish a new KARANCHO

foundation by their neighboring towns and provinces in order to accomplish its primary function in sowing the seeds of peace and harmony. ( As amended on January 27,1999)

B. Specific Objectives:

1. To attain the Vision, Goal and Mission set forth to its Constitution and By-laws.

## AMENDMENTS

### KARANCHO By Laws

Section 1. ANNUAL MEETINGS - The annual meetings of the members shall be held at the principal office of the association on JANUARY 27 of each year.

Section 2. BI-ANNUAL METTINGS- All KARANCHO Chapter Chairmen shall conduct meetings twice a year every last Friday till Sunday night of the months of February and August purposely for evaluation and enhancement. . ( As amended on January 27,1999

Section 3. MONTHLY SPECIAL MEETINGS – Chapter Monthly / Special meetings of the members shall be called every end of the month by Chairman of the Chapter. During such meetings, the Chairman shall render his monthly report to the members regarding the activities of the association.

Special meetings may be called as the need thereof arises, by the Board of Trustees or the President or upon petition of 1/3 of the general membership.

Section 3. NOTICES – Notices of the date, time and place of annual monthly and special meetings of the members shall be given either personally or by special delivery mail, and should be posted in the Bulletin Board, at least one week before the date set for such meeting. In urgent cases, the notice may be communicated at least two days before the meeting personally or by telephone or by telegram if contact is not possible and will be posted in the same Bulletin Board, the notice of every special meeting shall state briefly the purpose or purposes of the meeting. No other business shall be considered at such meeting, except with the consent of all the members present.

Section 4. WAIVER OF NOTICE – Notice of Meeting may be waived verbally by any member attending it.



Section 5. QUORUM - A quorum for any meeting of the members shall consists of a majority of the members and a majority of such quorum may decide any question at the meeting, except those matters where the Corporation Code requires the affirmative vote of a greater proportion.

Section 6. ORDER OF BUSINESS- The order of business at the Annual Meeting of the members shall be as follows: Proof of Service of the required notice of the meeting, except when such notice is waived by the members constituting a quorum.

- g. Proof of the presence of a quorum.
- h. Reading and approval of the minutes of the previous annual meeting, except when such reading is dispensed with a majority vote of those presents.
- i. Unfinished business.
- j. Report of the President.
- k. Election of the Trustees for the ensuing year.
- l. Other matters.

The order of business at any meeting may be changed by a vote of a majority of the members present.

Section 7. VOTE – A members shall be entitled to one vote. However, a member maybe allowed to vote by proxy which shall be in writing and to be filed with the Secretary of the Association indicating thereto the person taking his place.

## ARTICLE II TRUSTEES

Section 1. BOARD OF TRUSTEES - The corporate powers of the Association shall be exercised, its business conducted and its property controlled by the Board of Trustees.

Section 2. QUALIFICATIONS – no members shall be eligible for the election to the Board of Trustees unless he has the following qualifications:

1. A member must be a Filipino citizen and of legal age.
2. A member must be in good moral character.
3. Must be in good standing

Section 3. DISQUALIFICATION OF DIRECTORS, TRUSTEES OR OFFICERS.- No member convicted by final judgment of an offense punishable by imprisonment for a period exceeding six (6) years, or a violation of this code, committed within five (5) years prior to the date of election or appointment shall qualify as a trustees or officer and having conflicting interest with the activities of the association.

## ARTICLE III

### OFFICERS

Section 1. OFFICERS - The officers of the Association shall be a President, a Vice President, Secretary General, Asst. Secretary, National Administrator, Treasurer, an Auditor, PRO, Sergeant at Arms, Liaison Officer. They shall be elected by the Board of Trustees from among themselves. The Board may combine compatible offices in a single person.,. ( As amended on January 27,1999

Section 2. TERM OF OFFICE OF OFFICERS - All Officers of the Association shall hold office for two (2) years. However, no officer shall serve for the same position more than two (2) consecutive terms.

## ARTICLE IV

### FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF NATIONAL EXECUTIVE OFFICERS

Section 1. PRESIDENT - The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Association. In addition to duties as such, he shall preside in all meetings of the Board of Trustees and those of the members of the Association.

He shall execute all resolution and/or decisions of the Board of Trustees. He shall be charged with directing and overseeing the activities of the Association. He shall appoint and have control over all in employees of the association, review and approve disbursement/s authorized by the Board Together with the Secretary of the Association, he shall present to the Board of Trustees and the members an Annual Budget and from time to time as may be necessary, supplemental budgets. He shall submit to the Board of Trustees as soon as possible after the close of each fiscal year, and to the members of each annual meeting, a complete report of the activities and operations of the Association for the fiscal year under his term.

Section 2. VICE PRESIDENT- The Vice-President shall exercise all powers and perform all duties of the President during the absence or in capacity of the latter and shall perform duties that may be assigned by the Board of Trustees.

Section 3. SECRETARY GENERAL - The Secretary General must be a citizen and resident of the Philippines shall give all the notices required by these by laws and keep the minutes of all meetings of the members of the Board of Trustees and of all meetings of the members and of the Board of Trustees and of all meetings of all Committees in a book kept for the purpose. He shall keep the seal of the corporation and affix such seal to any paper or instruments requiring the same. He shall have custody of the correspondence files and all other papers that are to be kept by the Treasurer. He shall maintain the members register, have charge of the bulletin board at the principal office of the association. He shall also perform all such other duties and work as the Board of Trustees may from time to time assign to him.

Section 3.A. Assistant Secretary – The assistant secretary shall take over duties and responsibilities of the secretary when the latter is absent or incapacitated to perform the duties of the office.

Section 4. TREASURER - The Treasurer shall have charge of the fund, receipt and disbursements of the association. He shall keep all moneys and other valuables of the association in such bank or banks as the Board of Trustees may designate. He shall keep and have charge of the Book of Accounts which shall be open for inspection by any member of the Board of Trustees, whenever required, an account of financial conditions of the association and of all transactions made up by him as Treasurer. He shall also perform such other duties and functions as may be assigned to him from time to time by the Board of Trustees. He shall post a bond in such amount as may be fixed by the Board of Trustees.

Section 5. AUDITOR - The Auditor shall from time to time inspect, examine and audit the Book of accounts kept by the Treasurer and attend to the correctness of the Financial Report that maybe submitted by the Treasurer to the Board and/or to the Association.

Section 6. ADMINISTRATOR - The Administrator shall be responsible in managing the day-to-day administrative function of the Association. He shall administer all the approved resolutions and/or decisions of the Board of Trustees and send Memorandum Circulara of the same to different chapters. ( As amended on January 27,1999)

He shall submit to the Board of Trustees as soon as possible after the close of each fiscal year shall submit a complete administrative report of the activities and operations of the Association for the fiscal year under his term. ( As amended on January 27,1999)

Section 7. LIAISON OFFICER - The Liaison Officer shall follow-up matters related to welfare and benefits due to all members. He shall also perform other functions as may be provided by the Board of Trustees.. ( As amended on January 27,1999)

Section 8. CHAPTER OFFICERS - The chapter officers shall be composed of Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Auditor, PIO, Liaison Officer, and Sgt. At Arms and shall be responsible in running the chapter affairs in its own area of operation. They will serve as mediator on minor

cases for amicable settlement. ( As amended on January 27,1999)

Section 9. PROVINCIAL ADVISER - In case of misunderstanding between KARANCHO Chapters, he/she shall summon both chapters and shall pacify the said conflict with or without proper request of the complaining party to avoid further injuries. . ( As amended on January 27,1999)

Section 10. CHAPTER CIVILIAN ADVISER – The Municipal or City Mayor shall serve as the Chapter Adviser for one year and shall pacify the conflict between civilian KARANCHO against Civilian KARANCHO in his/her area of responsibility. . ( As amended on January 27,1999)

Section 11. CHAPTER PNP ADVISER- The PNP Chief of Police in the locality shall serve as the Chapter Adviser for one year duration and shall pacify individual misunderstanding between PNP and the Civilian KARANCHO member in his area of responsibility.(As amended on January 27,1999)

Section 12. NATIONAL CONSULTANTS - Anyone possesses technical expertise regarding human resource development and legal matters as well, the same shall be appointed by the Trustees whose length of service shall not be less than two(2) years. Extension of his/her services to the organization shall also be determined based on the level of the trust and confidence he/she displayed to the entire KARANCHO family nationwide and the members towards him or her. . ( As amended on January 27,1999)

## ARTICLE V MEMBERS

**Section 1. QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP** - The Board shall determine the qualifications of an applicant for membership. The qualification of membership shall be the following: . ( As amended on January 27,1999)

- a. Promote unity, solidarity, brotherhood to every KARANCHO member.
- b. Must know how to respect one another
- c. Must know how to adapt maximum patience and humility.
- d. Must know how to forgive the erring brothers and individuals.
- e. Must maintain the flag lit of KARANCHO in good standing.
- f. Must wear and display the KARANCHO tag at all times.
- g. Must follow the traffic rules and regulations of the Philippines.
- h. Must be a driver license holder.
- i. Must observe safety driving procedure.
- j. Must abide the constitution and bylaws of the KARANCHO.

**Section 2. RIGHTS OF MEMBERS** - A member shall have the following rights:

- f. To exercise the rights to vote on all matters relating to the affairs of the association.
- g. To be eligible to any elective or appointive office of the association
- h. To participate in all deliberation /meeting of the association.
- i. To avail of all the facilities of the association.
- j. To examine all records or books of the association during business hours.

**Section 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE MEMBERS** - A member shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. To obey and comply with the By-Laws, rules and regulations that may be promulgated by the association from time –to-time.
- b. To attend all meetings that may be called upon by the Board of Trustees.
- c. To pay membership dues and other assessments of the association.
- d. To promote the aims and purposes of the association, the success of its organization, the welfare of its members and the association as a whole.

**Section 4. CATEGORY OF MEMBERSHIP** - Membership categories to be identified through authorized insignia and patches ( As amended on January 27,1999)

1. **Membership in Highest Degree of Merit** (silver leaf of laurel and trekker patch to

be awarded by the Guest of Honor during National KARANCHO affair to be given to)

- a. Any public official who had displayed a sincere social services that was truly benefited by the general public.
- b. While in the course of assistance during fire incident, have had evacuated an abandoned child, disabled person and or unconscious inhabitants within or nearby the vicinity of a burning house.
- c. During vehicular accident, have had rescued victims who are on eminent danger like for example by initiating a heavy equipment or any special devices to pull out the victim/s beneath the wrecked vehicle.
- d. On flood disaster, have displayed courageous rescue of victims by his means of which, if not of the said initiative the victim would surely die.
  - i. ( note: any of the above)
- e. Had served the KARANCHO for at least two years
- f. Have maintained a good standing category by donating his dues without personal favor and malicious intent to gain

**2. Membership in Exemplary Standing** (Trekker patch to be awarded by the National Office during Regional and Provincial affairs)

- a. Have extended effort and or assisted/participated in the sowing of seeds of peace and harmony by organizing a new KARANCHO Chapter not least than seven (7) chapters.
- b. Had upheld justice by testifying in the witness stand on heinous crimes and or assisted the law enforcers leading to the apprehension of the suspect/s.
  - i. ( note: any of the above)
- c. Have had attended a KARANCHO National activities.
- d. Have maintained the member in good standing category.

**3. Membership in Meritorious Standing** ( KARANCHO) patch with four silver buttons of stars inside to be awarded by the chapter chairman

- a. Have had commence an act of brotherhood towards his fellow KARANCHO by acting as a true brother in time of mishap and personal necessities.
- b. Have had donated his blood to the national red cross
- c. Have had rescued victims of vehicular accident and facilitated the request to contact the parents, relatives or spouses of the victims.
  - i. ( note: any of the above)
- d. Have received public citations from public officials where he resides.
- e. Have maintained the member in good standing category.

**4. Membership in Good Standing** (KARANCHO) patch with three silver buttons of stars inside to be awarded by the chapter chairman

- a. Have been affiliated with the KARANCHO.
- b. Have attended the KARANCHO regular meeting.
- c. Have paid his monthly dues.

**5. Honorary Members** (KARANCHO) patch with two silver buttons of stars inside awarded by the chapter Chairman

- a. Have technically or financially supports the KARANCHO sustainability
- b. Have had provided facilities to the KARANCHO chapter.

**6. Ordinary Members** (KARANCHO) patch with one silver button of star inside.

- a. Active in the locality.
- b. Have had participated ten times touring activities of the

chapter.

(Note: the first and second award shall be supported with a certified write up and endorsement of the Local Officials and or COP of the PNP in the locality duly supported with letter of authority by the Central Office.)

## **Section 5. COURTESY TO THE AWARDEES**( As amended on January 27,1999)

1. Courtesy to the awardees of highest degree of merit -
  - a. all KARANCHO members shall extend utmost courtesy to any person wearing the said insignia and shall be greeted first before others and must be addressed as "high degree".
  - b. Ex. High Degree Robert Advencula
2. To the exemplary standing- shall be respected as an honorable person and shall be addressed as "EXE-S".
  - a. Ex. EXE-S Robert Advincula.

## **Section 6. MORAL AND WELFARE of the Members** ( As amended on Jan. 27,1999)

### **1. Awards**

#### **a. Merits**

- a. To be awarded after thorough evaluation and screening during KARANCHO National Chapter Chairmen's meetings

#### **b. Silver buttons**

- a. To be determine by the higher government officials or the KARANCHO National Office

#### **c. Recognition**

- a. Certificate of recognitions and plaque of appreciation from the public, government agencies and the KARANCHO family

### **2. Pre-need Insurance**

- a. Availability of the group insurance privilege.
- b. Availability of voluntary financial assistance

### **3. Network Assistance** - All active KARANCHO members shall be assisted courteously after showing all his credential and updated efficiency card

## **Section 7. COMPULSORY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

( As amended on January 27,1999)

- a. **In case of break down** - No one shall leave any KARANCHO members with corresponding KARANCHO identity along the road who are in need of help.
- b. **In case of accident** - No one shall leave any KARANCHO members who are victim of accident in the hospital without informing his parents, relatives and or spouses.
- c. **In case of social conflict** - No one shall inflict injuries to any KARANCHO members except during self- defense.

## **Section 8. RULES AND REGULATIONS:** ( As amended on January 27,1999)

- a. **Diligence** - Active KARANCHO member
  - i. Shall gave a monthly efficiency card duly signed by the chapter chairman

- ii. Shall not enjoy the network assistance except on time of emergency

**b. Greetings rule - KARANCHO Hail**

- i. Only KARANCHO chairmen, toast master an or designated person can challenge the KARANCHO hail:
- ii. It must be done during opening and closing of the program and on special occasions of which the chairman shall determine the necessity in doing so. This must be treated as a sacred greetings.

**c. Hand shaking.**

- i. Every KARANCHO shall extend his/her left hand for and shaking to every KARANCHO he or she meets.
- ii. Hand shaking should be observed with dignity and Honor.

**d. Hand greetings.**

- i. When riding a motorbike or four-wheeled vehicle, the One who first see the other KARANCHO riding in a motorbike or a four wheeled vehicle must do the hand greetings.
- ii. Failure to respond must be avoided in order not to cause ill feeling to KARANCHO brothers.

**Section 9. TOURING RULES.** : ( As amended on January 27,1999)

- a. Before moving from any places, the battalion commander shall see to it that all his men are completely on the line
- b. Never move the troops not unless all are in tacked.
- c. While at the same time, the rear scout shall give signal after all are ready to move.
- d. While cruising, everybody must observed the first rule- **no over taking unless necessary.**
- e. Gave way to the rear scout while he is overtaking to avoid delay of his message to the battalion commander.

**Section 10. HAND SIGNALS** - Thumbs up greeting shall be always the left hand. Every one who participates the touring must execute the proper hand signal given by the battalion commander or the touring team leader. : ( As amended on January 27,1999)

**Section 11. LIGHT SIGNAL** - "Lights on" is a must to all KARANCHO members whether in group or in a single travel even on broad day light. Shall alert the opposite KARANCHO vehicles upon sighting with his/her light dimmer : ( As mended on January 27,1999)

**Section 12. PARKING** - Park the motorbike or vehicle always in an alert position. Always park your bike or vehicle to the designated parking area. See to it that parked motorbike is locked. ( As amended on January 27,1999)

**Section 13. ATTENDANCE** - Listing of K-members is a must during touring by the designated Secretary. The Battalion Commander is responsible to the safety and security of all KARANCHO during touring. ( As amended on January 27,1999)

**Section 14. ACQUISITION AND USAGE OF K-PARAPHERNALIA.** . ( As amended on January 27,1999)

**a. Uniform**

1. Acquisition of Uniform must be supported by an authorization from the K-Chairman.
2. Note to Purchase from the Chairman must be presented to National Office.
3. Only those who are active and or regular K-members can be issued an authority to acquire of any KARANCHO paraphernalia.
4. Proper wearing of K- uniform must be observed and shall at all time be monitored by the K-Chapter officers.
5. K-Uniform shall be used during monthly meeting, parade, personal travel with travel order, and other group activities.

**b. Tag**

1. Acquisition of K-Tag shall be approved by the K-Chairman accompanied by a "Note to Acquire" duly signed by the Chairman.
2. K-tag shall be worn and boldly displayed by all members for immediate identification.
3. Hand shaking shall not be responded to any K- members not wearing K-tag.

**c. Flag lets**

1. Acquisition of K-Flag shall be approved by the K-Chairman and shall accompany "Note to acquire" duly signed by the K-Chairman.
2. K-flag shall be mounted on the left side of the motorbike or four-wheeled vehicle.
3. K-flag shall be rolled when borrowed by non-K-members so as to avoid embarrassment by other K-members.
4. Lost k-flag must be replaced and reported to K-Chairman.

**d. ID**

1. Every member must take and pass the K- refresher course exam before he / she be issued an ID by the Chairman
2. Acquisition of K-ID must be accompanied by "Note to Purchase" from K-Chairman.
3. ID's must bear the signature of the K-Chairman, City or Municipal Mayor, Chief of Police and the Provincial Adviser.
4. Lost IDs must be reported immediately to the K-Chairman.

**Section 15. COORDINATING RULES.** (As amended on January 27,1999)

- a. Before and After KARANCHO foundation - Courtesy to the Mayor and courtesy to the PNP Chief of Police .
- b. During Calamities and Disasters – PDCC, MDCC, MSWD, RED CROSS, Brgy CAPTAINS, Other NGO's

**Section 16. RULES IN THE CONDUCT OF MEETINGS.** (As amended on Jan 27,1999)

1. Setting an Agenda for board meeting
  - a. Any complaint, proposals and or recommendation to the Board by the members shall be endorsed to the KARANCHO Secretary in

writing and shall be furnish to all members of the board,

- b. The board of directors shall determine the validity and viability of said endorsement wherein any member of the board interested to sponsor such shall call the attention of the Secretary and shall notify the chairman of the board for the insertion to the agenda for the next regular and or special meeting.
- c. All issues shall have a sponsor for future recognition and reference.
- d. All the rest shall accord to the parliamentary rules.

**Section 17. KARANCHO OFFICERS MEETING.** ( As amended on Jan. 27,1999)

- A. Enhancement Programs** - Shall maintain motivating program of activities attractive to the members
- B. Developmental Project** - Shall initiate and or participate developmental project beneficial to the community
- C. Preventive Project** - Shall at all time maintain peace and order

**Section 18. FELLOWSHIP MEETING-** Conduct during Fellowship Meeting shall follow the Order of the Meeting. . ( As amended on Jan. 27,1999)

- i. Invocation
- ii. National anthem
- iii. KARANCHO hail
- iv. K-accomplishment updates
- v. Reiterate all local accomplishments of every individual and shall properly be recorded for future reference during evaluation of awards.
- vi. Dissemination of information and updates of new KARANCHO directives
- vii. KARANCHO critics - Everybody shall give their critics and opinion in a nice and constructive manner for better improvements and shall be noted to avoid repetition
- viii. KARANCHO grievance revelation - Shall reveal his/her grievances without mentioning the name of the subject.
- ix. Subsequently, the most ranking KARANCHO shall call the attention of the subject if he is around and call him to stand through his own volition/will. If in case the subject would not submit himself, by the power vested to the said most ranking KARANCHO OFFICER, he/she shall request the aggrieve party to mention the name of the respondent in a nice manner.
- x. KARANCHO repentance- The subject must stand to explain his side whether he is right or wrong wherein upon submission of himself, he must ask an apology.
- xi. If the subject is forgiven, everybody shall clap their hands to show acceptance of the subject's repentance.
- xii. Conversely, if the respondent could not accept his fault, the body shall be divided to decide whether he/she is guilty or not and a punishment shall be incurred to her/him by an execution of ten times push-up.
- xiii. If the subject could not still accept the verdict, the chairman shall assume the punishment wherein as a



consequence, the subject will be expelled and black listed to all KARANCHO Chapters.

**Section 19. RULES DURING AMICABLE SETTLEMENT.** .( As amended on Jan. 27,1999)

**A. Internal conflict- KARANCHO CHAPTER TO CHAPTER Misunderstanding**

- a. The issue must be brought out first to the KARANCHO Provincial Adviser.
- b. If in case the Misunderstandings was kept by both parties, upon verification found true and correct, by the authority of the KARANCHO Provincial Adviser she/he can invite/summon both and shall pacify the said conflict with or without proper request of the complaining party.

**B. Individual misunderstanding**

- a. Between PNP and Civilian KARANCHO, the Chief Of Police shall pacify the two parties.
- b. Between the Civilian KARANCHO against Civilian KARANCHO, the Mayor shall pacify the said conflict.
- c. On minor cases, any KARANCHO members and officers can mediate the issue for amicable settlement.

**C. KARANCHO organization against other entity -** If and when without provocation from the KARANCHO side annoyed and or insulted by other entities, formal complaint must be made against the aggressor after all effort of amicable settlement failed.

**2. Vehicular accident**

- a. Facilitate for evacuation of the victims to hospital
- b. Take their names and relatives to be contacted and leave your telephone number or referrals so they can make follow-up request.
- c. Request neighboring KARANCHO to pass through radio message or telephone long distance and further request to contact the relatives of the victims.
- d. The receiving KARANCHO shall find means to locate the requested person and shall take their names and relationship and likewise leave his telephone numbers or radio frequency.
- e. Post KARANCHO posters to all hospitals for the information of the public where they can seek assistance.

**3. Fire incident**

- a. Do not rush to the burning house without proper evaluation
- b. Try to inspect the adjacent house if there are people trapped, abandoned and or locked children inside the house and they must be attended first before others.

**4. Flood disasters**

- a. Prepare all necessary equipment before going to the scene
- b. Organize committees for contingencies
- c. Take note all the names of rescued people and children
- d. Assist evacuees on salvaging their things

**5. Public information and dissemination**

- a. Against wrong perception and negative opinion
- b. Gossip and mongering shall be discourage, suppress, stop if necessary to avoid adverse effect.

**6. Crime awareness and preparedness**

- a. Negligible wrong deeds must be prevented to avoid it going worst in a nice way or through campaign
- b. Petty crimes shall be prevented to avoid the tendency of becoming hardcore criminal.

**7. Livelihood program**

- a. Sustainability- economic patronage
- b. Economic security - Livelihood program

ARTICLE VI

SUSPENSION, EXPULSION AND TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Suspension, expulsion and termination of membership, shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the association and of the corporation code of the Philippines.

Any member of the association may file charges against a member by filing a written complaint with the Secretary of the Association. The Board of Trustees shall call a special meeting of the members to consider the charges. The affirmative vote of 1/3 of all the members of the association shall be necessary to suspend a member; provided that were the penalty is expulsion the affirmative vote of 2/3 of all the members shall be necessary to expel a member.

Any member may be suspended, expelled or terminated from the association for acts, inimical, prejudicial or contrary to the rights, welfare and interest of the association and/or any of its members.

a) The specific act and surrounding circumstances shall be reflected in a written complaint by any member or non-member to be submitted to the Secretary or the Committee on Investigation and Disciplinary Action which shall function and act upon said complaint strictly in accordance with the due process of law.

b) The extent of the irregularity done or the gravity of the offense committed will be the basis of the Committee's action on the complaint, with rebuke or reprimand as the lightest action.

c) Any member meted out with the penalty of expulsion or termination automatically losses his rights and benefits of membership; and all dues and fees paid by him shall be forfeited in favor of the association. The subject will be required to turn over his KARANCHO uniform, and flag to the President.

d) In the event that a chapter or zone suffers an erosion of members behavior, and rampant of non feasances, misfeasances and malfeasances grossly violating the concept and objectives of the association and inimical to its integrity, the KARANCHO officialdom of the umbrella organization will have the option to cause for the disbanding of that chapter or zone, and to cause for the confiscation of all KARANCHO uniforms and other related and identifying materials from all the members of that unit, thus, finishing the

ultimate act of dissolving it.

ARTICLE VII  
FUND

Section 1. FUNDS – the funds of the association shall be derived from admission/membership fees, annual/monthly dues and special assessment of members, gifts, donations or benefits.

Section 2. FEES AND DUES - Every member of the association shall in addition to the membership fee pay dues and/or assessments that may imposed by the association from time to time.

Section 3. DISBURSEMENTS – Withdrawal from the funds of the association whether by check or any other instrument shall be signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by the President. If necessary, the Board of Trustees may designate other signatories.

Section 4. FISCAL YEAR - The fiscal year of the association shall be from January 1 to December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.

ARTICLE VIII  
CORPORATE SEAL

Section 1. FORM - The corporate seal of the association shall be in such form and design as may be determined by the Board.

ARTICLE IX  
AMENDMENTS OF THE BY-LAWS

Section 1. AMENDMENTS – These By-Laws, or any provision thereof, may be amended or repealed by a majority vote of the members and by a majority vote of the Trustees at any regular or special meeting duly held for the purpose.

## KARANCHO PRIMER

THIS PRIMER IS PRESENTED IN THE MOST CONVENTIONAL QUESTION AND ANSWER METHOD  
(EXCEPT FOR THE PREFACE) FOR EASY COMPRHENSION OF MEMBERS AND WOULD-BE  
MEMBERS.

### A - PREFACE:

The KARANCHO as organization was conceived when Region 11 PNP Regional Director P/C

**SUPT JOSE C. LALISAN, JR.** verbally suggested an idea patterned from PNP GHQ Crame to Davao Norte PNP Provincial Director **P/ SUPT ALEJANDRO GUTIERREZ** for the creation and establishment of a well organized group that can magnify the new image of the PNP and to ultimately win the responsive support of the community to the PNP, one that will have the semblance in effect with the present and prevalent communications oriented organizations in the Province.

In the process of discussion, the PNP Regional Director zeroed on motorcycle owners roaming the streets as potentials if properly tapped and motivated for voluntary membership, and for the organization to closely adhere to the concept on Community Organization and Mobilization under the program of the **Police Community Relations Offensive per guideline in its IMPLAN.**

The Davao del Norte PNP Provincial Director then tasked the PNP PCR Section through its PCR Officer **P/CI Rodolfo Huerta** for this task who called his staff to a consultative meeting which ended up by tasking the **PCR PNCO SPO3 Carlito B. Barena** to initiate and perform the task desired using his creative and innovative skills and his vast experiences of handling identical situations.

**SPO3 BARENA** assumed the responsibility and asked a free hand to do it not in the manner of Police Procedure but to organize it in a civilian way, because it will not only be the **PNP** concern but the **DILG** concern as well, which was granted. He took it as a rare opportunity to maximize the implementation of a PCR project on Community Organization and Community Interrelation that can develop **Institutional Support through Networking and liaisioning** with the five identified most credible institutions of society which are Congress, the church, media, NGOs and the School for positive realization of **Community Organization and Mobilization**, and being a **multi-sectoral representations**, it will be a civic oriented organization.

And so, with the different sectors of society to constitute the general membership, and the invaluable support and active participation of the Local Government of Tagum under the able stewardship of **Mayor Victorio Suaybaguio, Jr.** whose leadership and capability made him the President of the League of Municipalities of the Philippines, Davao Province Chapter, added by the positive acceptance of different NGOs on the capability of this group to function, **KARANCHO was born.** But its birth from the early stage of organization could not have been made possible by **SPO3 Barena** alone without the contributions of those who labored in the planning and campaign stages like **Benigno”Bong” Andamon, Allan Rellon, Allan Pereyras, Joemelo Agustin Bucoy** and the present officials and members of the Board of Directors. **KARANCHO** hinges on the restoration of our lost Filipino Cultures and Moral Values and to cultivate these as the umbra in the framing of its Constitution and By-Laws.

## **B - QUESTION AND ANSWER:**

### **1. Q - What is this KARANCHO?**

**A -** It is one of those common street parlance or jargon which means working partner but to read out, it is the acronym of **KABABAYAN RIDERS ASSOCIATION FOR A NEW CULTURAL HARMONY AND ORDER**, which is **KARANCHO** for short. It is a civic oriented association of motorcycle riders and owners of Davao Province.

### **2. Q - What is its Purpose?**

**A -** It aims for the restoration of our Filipino culture and development of our moral and spiritual values as the key for the promotion of harmony among men. It will strive to achieve where the other groups had failed in restoring some of those values. Respect, compassion and humility are some of our precious and vital values seldom heard of and practiced nowadays.

### **3. Q - Is it merely for Funs and Frolics?**

**A -** Definitely, not because this is a multi-sector representation of individuals with motorcycles of from small up to big bikes, dedicated to render public service with the sublime resolve of being respectable, virtuous, trustworthy and credulous in the community. It is not just bunch of personalities organized merely for fun or joy riding.

### **4. Q - How can the preceding objectives be attained?**

**A -** These are the **KARANCHO specific Objectives?**

1. To primarily promote love, respect, brotherhood, unity, awareness, harmony, humility, and understanding and of mutual assistance in pursuing, promoting and protecting the common

and individual rights, benefits, welfare and interests of the individual members, as well as the community;

2. To develop the "KARANCHO or Kauban Concept" into an institution of lofty concern citizens that can be depended upon during times of distress and utmost needs;

3. To be an effective conduit of the government and the private sectors and NGOs in carrying out assistance projects and programs designed to promote and uplift the general welfare and interest of the community;

4. To conduct fellowship of members for familiarization and socials, motorcycle fun/joy riding and other allied activities to establish genuine brotherhood and coherence among members;

5. To assist and serve as an auxiliary force in promoting various government programs and networking services considering this as a formidable group with multi-sector membership equipped with the needed capability to effectively perform and function;

6. With God' help, it will assume its nationalistic heritage in whatever manner and for whatever task it may be requested to and assigned by duly constituted authorities and top leaders in promoting, securing and preserving the peace and order of Davao in particular and the country in general, as well as the restoration of our moral values, preservation of our superfluous virtues and the revival of our Filipino Cultural Beliefs;

5. **Q** - Is **membership to the KARANCHO** limited only to peace officers, government officials and employees, and the community, civic, and religious leaders?

**A** - Absolutely No!

6. **Q** - **How** can one be a member?

**A** - Every one is welcome for membership provided he meets the **qualifications**, foremost of all is that he must be of legal age, of good moral character and reputation and will voluntarily signify to abide by the basic rules, regulations and restrictions to wit:

1. MUST KNOW HOW TO RESPECT ONE ANOTHER, its motto;

2. MUST BE OWNER OF A MOTORCYCLE;

3. NOT THE OWNER BUT THE HOLDER OF A MEMORANDUM RECEIPT TO WHOM THE

UNIT IS ISSUED BY THE EMPLOYER/COMPANY/ENTITY MAY BE CONSIDERED ON A

CASE-TO-CASE BASIS DEPENDING ON THE ACTION OF THE SCREENING/ADMISSION

COMMITTEE;

4. MUST BE A LICENCED DRIVER;

5. MUST BE EMPLOYED OR IS SELF EMPLOYED;

6. MUST NOT INDULGE IN LIQUOR DURING DRIVING ACTIVITY;

7. UNIT MUST BE COMPLETE IN ACCESSORIES AND DOCUMENTS;

8. HELMET IS A MUST WHEN DRIVING;

9. MUST BE IN PRESCRIBED ATTIRE DURING GROUP TOURS.

7. **Q** - Are there **other requirements** like fees aside from those qualifications and rules and regulations enumerated?

**A** - Yes! There is Membership Fee of One Hundred Pesos(P100), and a monthly dues of Twenty Five

( P 25 ) pesos to be paid to the Chapter Treasurer which will be duly receipted;

8. **Q** - Why are there monetary obligations to members? Is this not a non-stock Association?

**A** - YES! This is a multi-sector, non stock, non-profit association, **but it has the plan and protraction of going into a COOPERATIVE venture for any income generating endeavor that the general membership may so opt and elect. Besides, those fees are for the association's operations and other utmost needs.**

9. **Q** - Since money of members are involved as funds, is the **keeping of cash and**

**monies** only entrusted to an individual personality, say the Treasurer?

**A** - The KARANCHO even in its infancy has already an assigned and designated depository and service bank situated here in Tagum where all monies of the association are deposited; and all transactions of deposits and withdrawals can only be done through the signatures of the three authorized signatories who are the President, the Treasurer and the Auditor of the Association.

10. **Q** - What will happen to a member who had already complied with all the requirements including monies but had **transgressed and committed some irregularities**?

**A** - In the Association By-Laws and under its suspension, expulsion a termination provision, any member may be suspended, expelled or terminated from the association for acts inimical, prejudicial or contrary to the rights, welfare and interest of the association.

The specific act and surrounding circumstances will be reflected in a written complaint by any member or none member to be submitted to the Secretary or the Committee on Investigation and Disciplinary Action which shall function and act upon said complaint strictly in accordance with due process of law.

Any member meted out with the penalty of expulsion or termination automatically loses his rights and benefits to membership; and all dues and fees paid by him to the association shall be forfeited in favor of the association. The subject shall ultimately be required to turn over his KARANCHO uniform and flag to the Chairman.

11. **Q** - Supposing a Chapter or Zone **Suffers an erosion** of member's behavior and nonfeasance and malfeasances already inimical to the general welfare of the KARANCHO, will that Chapter or Zone continue to exist and function?

**A** - Should that condition exists or predominant in any Chapter or Zone, the KARANCHO Officialdom of the umbrella organization will have no other option but to cause for the disbanding of that chapter or zone, and to cause for the confiscation of all KARANCHO uniforms and other identifying materials from all the members of that unit as the ultimate act of dissolving it.

12. **Q** - Who **runs and manages** the Association's affair.

**A** - The Association has five ( 5) officers namely: The President, the Vice-President, the Secretary, the Treasurer and the Auditor. They are the overseer of the day to day functions and activities of the association with the President in the helm exercising wide authority on supervision, control and management. There are ten(10) members of the Board of Directors comprising the policy making body of the Association. They are all elected at large by the general membership.

13. **Q** - How long will these **officers and members of the Board of Directors** hold office?

**A** - They will hold office for the period of two(2) Years until their successors have been elected and qualified.

14. **Q** - Is KARANCHO already **clothe with juridical personality**?

**A** - After its Constitution and By Laws shall have been finalized and satisfied by the necessary majority votes, KARANCHO will work for its registration with the Securities and Exchanger Commission.

15. **Q** - **How was KARANCHO organized?** Was it done in one instant already with such an immense membership?

**A** - It was a tedious task made possible by great amount of patience and perseverance. It was started on APRIL 10 by three (3) eager and energetic persons with synonymous ideals whose persistence and determination resulted to a twenty five (25) attendance the next meeting on April 21 and had swollen to fifty six (56) during its meeting on April 28 when the formal organization was announced to take place



on May 5. It was a success for the eager participants volunteering for membership had reached eighty-nine (89) on May 5, 1996. The election officers were held resulting to the present set-up. Right away the Board of Directors and Officers convened and worked for the drafting of its Constitution and By-Laws, and which shall be submitted in its final form to the general membership after the launching and induction of its officers for participation. KARANCHO now holds a membership of One-hundred and Twenty-Five as of July.

16. **Q** - What assurance does this association hold for its **growth and expansion**?

**A** - Although it is premature to make an assurance, yet one solid and irrefutable fact is the interest of members-to-be who are asking for admission and membership forms daily for formal affiliation.

Another indisputable basis is its adoption in the Municipal level under the auspices of the PNP, adhering to its original concept, form, and essence. For sure **KARANCHO** will expand and from **MICRO** it will go **MACRO**.

17. **Q** - What present latent signs can be considered as positive manifestations of it **growing BIG**?

**A** - These may not be enough but are considerable warranty, namely:

1. The early endorsements of support from our Provincial and Municipal leaders because of their trust and confidence in its capability to function;
2. The positive image seen by the community reflecting it as a well - disciplined group dedicated to assist the community in livelihood, social, and civic action and on disaster and relief operation;
3. The different segments of society are represented in the association as it is multi-sectoral, clarifying further that GOS and NGOS are among those properly represented;
4. The cohesiveness of members can be attributed to the fact that it is non-sectarian, non political, and founded on the foundation of "Respect One Another " and equality of all members in its membership to the association, promoting and putting into practice the spirit of brotherhood, harmony, understanding, love, humility and mutual assistance and camaraderie.
5. **KARANCHO** is not only a multi-sector community organization and mobilization, not only will it promote community interrelation through the development of institutional support through networking and liaisoning with the identified most credible institutions of the society, namely: Congress, Media, Church, Schools and NGOs, but it will promote and effectuate communications and monitoring in the most in the most reliable, fast and dependable way as it covers a wider scope and area due to the personal direct involvement of members who are the competent representations of the different sectors of our society, enjoying the trust and confidence of their fellow constituents.

18. **Q** - In answer, 16, no 2, it states that KARANCHO will assist the community in civic action and on disaster and relief operations. How will KARANCHO act and move during disaster and relief operations or on any eventualities.

**A** - It has already organized its members into different teams to handle any emergency situations as above mentioned. Then it will observe the following steps:

1. Always coordinate with the agency and authority concern;
2. Systematic deployment of teams to specific tasking;
3. Head count before and after operation;
4. Respective teams will have detailed record of their participation and operation.

**KARANCHO** is now in place ready to assume its multifarious responsibilities to the government and the community, being civic oriented. It will soon be clothed with juridical personality and the inherent obligation to be responsive to society. After June 11, 1996 when it was formally launched and its set of officers officially sworn to office, it started its full **COMMISSIONSHIP**.

**KARANCHO** is non-government civic oriented organization on wheels easy to assemble in times of distress and all kinds of crisis considering its instrument of mobility. It is a troupe and assemblage of well disciplined and responsive individuals with zeal and dedication that can immediately function **WHEREVER** and **WHENEVER** needed.

## **ORIENTATION GUIDELINES IN THE ORGANIZATION OF KARANCHO CHAPTER**

**KARANCHO** is the acronym of **KABABAYAN RIDERS ASSOCIATION FOR A NEW CULTURAL HARMONY AND ORDER**. It is a civic organization of motorcycle riders/drivers of all walks of life coming from the different sectors of the community.

**KARANCHO** was conceived not that it is the ultimate hope of restoring our Filipino culture, but it resolved to do where other groups and organizations had failed. In our present era, we can clearly see the fast fading away of what is left of our original moral values and cultural beliefs. Nowadays, a gallant young man helping an old man to cross the street is subjected to mockery and even humiliation. An old man approaching group of teenagers is already the one who will give the usual salutation and respect fearful that he will be a victim of "paregla". Children are no longer taking notice of the arrival of their parents from work to get their hands and bring it forth to their foreheads as signs of ultimate respect, and children no longer making the sign of the cross and genuflecting when Angelus is sounded. Seldom can we see now a man offering his seat to an elderly in an overloaded vehicle of public conveyance.

So, if no one will initiate for the restoration of these neglected cultural values, now, who else will do it? KARANCHO was organized because of those few preceding remorseful facts and although it may not be the answer, yet, as a civic oriented group with lofty resolve for community service, it saddles upon itself two main objectives which are: (1) **Cultural Harmony** and (2) **Order**.

**1. CULTURAL HARMONY** can be attained through the **RESTORATION** of our **SUPERFLOUS** and **NEGLECTED VALUES** and **CULTURAL BELIEFS**. This can be made accessible if we will closely adhere to the KARANCHO MOTTO of "Respect One Another" which will develop **SELF CONFIDENCE** in us and lead us to the attainment of **COMMUNITY CONFIDENCE**, bringi9ng us to the attainment of **COMMUNITY FAMILIARIZATION**. With everyone enjoying that sphere of **BEING FAMILIARIZED WITH EACH OTHER AND EVERYONE**, we have ultimately achieved the most essential factor of an organization, which is **BROTHERHOOD**.

Living then by the **GOLDEN RULE** which mandates us to "**DO UNTO OTHERS WHAT YOU WISH OTHERS TO DO UNTO YOU**" and vice versa of "**DO NOT DO UNTO OTHERS WHAT YOU DON'T OTHERS TO DO UNTO YOU**", then those other Filipino **VALUES** and **VIRTUES** and **CULTURALBELIEFS** lost or neglected by the passing of time can be regained and relieved and shall be added unto us, like; **RESPECT, COMPASSION, UNITY, HUMULITY, CAMARADERIE** and **SOLIDARITY**.

In the aspect of **ORDER**, in like manner of a coin, if **ORDER** is the other side we see, the other side is **PEACE** and these two are inseparable and are complementing each other. **ORDER** can be best served thru **COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**.

**COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE** can be rendered by anybody regardless of social and financial standing because man by nature has that inherent and God given trait of extending help to someone in dire need of help but only devoid of the opportunity to do so, or if the chance to do it is present, he might be misunderstood as intending to do wicked or criminal acts or evil schemes. But there are lots of ways, instances and occasions that one can perform **COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE**: These are (A) during **CALAMITIES AND DISASTERS**, (B) in **CRIME PREVENTION**, (C) in **LAW ENFORCEMENT**, (D) as **CRIME DETERENT**.

(A) **CALAMITIES AND DISASTERS**: These can be done during the occurrences of fires, floods, traffic mishaps, inundations and other natural and man made catastrophes and tragedies thru **RESCUE** operations, the conduct of orderly **EVACUATION**. Distribution of **RELIEF** aids and other **ALLIED ASSISTANCE** coming from concerned government agencies, NGO's, Peoples Organization, and from the accumulated individual contributions of **KARANCHOS** or **ASSISTING** a survivor from capsized banca maneuvering a turbulent sea or a swollen river can be done by anyone. But the best **ASSISTANCE** that our KARANCHO has offered and done, and will ceaselessly do, was the lengthening of lives of those in the closest battle with life and death when **BLOOD** was pronounced as the only means of saving souls, for KARANCHO has sufficient blood deposits of **KARANCHO BLOOD** for the purpose. The above instances show that one need no be elite, rich, government official, a peace officer or a soldier in performing these tasks as even an ordinary citizen can do it. But best still, let it be done in a KARANCHO way, as we are now looked upon as the most reliable conduit of these institutions and our very own government.

(B) **CRIME PREVENTION** - For those who does not yet know the elements of crime, let it therefore be known now. The **DESIRE** and **INTENT** to commit a crime is present in a person in dire need to enjoy the fruit of that crime he intends to do, say – **MONEY** in theft and robbery. He roams and looks around for the **OPPORTUNITY** to carry out his nefarious scheme from somebody somewhere. Be then reminded that **DESIRE + OPPORTUNITY = CRIME**. It becomes therefore a duty for every **KARANCHOS** to propagate these message, and to to be **FIRST TO DETECT** these **OPPORTUNITIES** so that early **WARNING** and **ADVISE** can be given to those innocent victims-to-be to prevent the commission of the crime. Closely watching suspicious character and monitoring movements is another way of preventing crimes, advising neighbors to properly secure their houses at night and not to accept transients are other ways to prevent crimes; and all these will benefit a **KARANCHO PERSONALLY** as well as benefiting other **PERSONS** and **PARTIES**.

(C) **LAW ENFORCEMENT** – one need not to be a peace officer or a person in authority or an agent of such person in authority to be able to do law enforcement functions. A person actually present and had witnessed the commission of a crime or immediately after its commission can affect arrest thru the

**CITIZEN ARREST** so provided by law. But he must consider “**eminent danger**” to his own life and consider his capability to effect the task of arrest.

**KARANCHO** Maghari of Magatos, Asuncion Chapter, Davao del Norte and his two **KARANCHO** companions had taken all these considerations, but their inherent traits and seal, coupled with dedication and rare courage made the approach of the three unidentified persons riding the motorcycle from Kapalong, Davao Norte instead of the driver whom they knew so well, and who, sensing that Maghari really meant business, ran away but Maghari was able to take hold of one and his **KARANCHO** companions succeeded in apprehending the two others. When already at the Police Station of Kapalong where they were turned over by our **KARANCHO** heroes, it was gathered that they had made their 31<sup>st</sup> carnap count by that motorcycle, and further confessed that the driver whom they killed and hid in culvert is the 5<sup>th</sup> in the count. The body of the victim was found and recovered by our **KARANCHO** heroes.

Another example was when our **KARANCHO** frequency flashed an alarm of a hold up in progress in Tagum, Davao del Norte, and in less than 5 minutes, 50 Tagum **KARANCHOS** responded and had retrieved the hand bag, but the perpetrators, for their fear of the number of **KARANCHOS** attending to the call fled, aided by their mastery of the area.

(D) **CRIME DETERRENT - KARANCHO**, having successfully gained now the acceptance, acknowledgment and support of the community, the different NGOs and the government as a disciplined civic organization with the capability to function in any given situation has now accomplished its worthiness as **Community Oriented Policing System or “COPS” on the Road**. In its birthplace that is Tagum, 3 to 4 **KARANCHOS** at night making a round of Poblacion on their motorcycles, drive those “choys” and “chays” ahiding, and the admixture of **PNP** and civilian **KARANCHOS** raiding houses of ill-repute and other known places and dens, add to it the numerous peace keeping deeds it had done makes **KARANCHO** by itself already a **CRIME DETERRENT** that the mention of “**KARANCHO**” is already synonymous to **KAUBAN, COPS ON THE ROAD**; commanding authority and respect.

In the aspect of **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**, this has been done the **KARANCHO** way by: (A) **CIVIC ACTION ( CIVAC)**, (B) **TREE PLANTING** by way of the **CLEAN and GREEN** Program of the Government, (C) as a **COORDINATING ARM** of the Government, and (D) **CLOSELY COORDINATING** with other civic organizations.

(A) **CIVAC – Central KARANCHO** has already extended these services, first to the tribal ethnics of Talaingod and series of **CIVAC** to the fire victims of the Misa Fire of Tagum. These can be done by any **KARANCHO** group in so many ways.

(B) **TREE PLANTING - CLEAN AND GREEN PROGRAM**: This is self explanatory and can be done on an appointed date and on a place designated by your local planning committee with seedlings supplied by NGOs and the Government.

(C) **COORDINATING WITH GOVERNMENT**: Bear in mind that **KARANCHO** is to coordinate with the government, never to lead any government line agencies in its functions. But be ever ready at all times when such need and request for coordination reaches you for in the **KARANCHO**, rejecting such call is a **MOTRTAL SIN**.

(D) **COORDINATE AND COOPERATE with NGO and other CIVIC ORGANIZATIONS**: Having gained now the trust and confidence of **NGOs** and Civic Organizations of **KARANCHO's** willingness and capacity to perform, it is already a byword of these groups or institutions for any of their activities to turn to **KARANCHO** for coordination and cooperation, that for them, a vacuum do exists without **KARANCHO**.

So you, being now a part of **KARANCHO** should say, act, react, perform as a true **KARANCHO** in heart and in mind, that you shall never injure and tarnish the good name that **KARANCHO** had so painstakingly worked for and established.

## **MORAL, WELFARE AND PROTECTION SCHEME**

(A) **MORAL - KARANCHO** has already multifarious accomplishments that it can be proud of, done not for the aim of acclamation for honor but purely in line with its self-imposed objectives. As a consequence of it all, it had been **CREDITED for those ACHIEVEMENTS, and various CITATIONS and COMMENDATIONS** were awarded by the government and other NGOs. **KARANCHO**, in the other hand has planned to reward outstanding units / chapters and members who had performed extraordinary

community / civic services, and for heroic worthy of emulation.

(B) **WELFARE – KARANCHO** is now in its finalization of the design for its **WELFARE** Program, giving foremost consideration for **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** and **MORTUARY AID** to **KARANCHO** members and immediate relatives.

(C) **PROTECTION – KARANCHO** stands on its **DOGMA**, “**ONE FOR ALL AND ALL FOR ONE**” that the **DILEMA OF ONE** is the **DILEMA** for **ALL**, the **WOE of ONE** is the **WOE** for **ALL**, the **JOY of ONE** is the **JOY** for **ALL**.

## **COMMUNICATION, COORDINATION AND ACTION SYSTEM**

**Our KARANCHO** Communications Network is so fast and reliable as it is banking on and relying upon **PLECS**, the Provincial Law Enforcement Communication System established and installed in every municipal building overseered by the Mayor, linking every municipality and hooked to the Provincial Capitol. Now, we know that in every municipality, all Barangay Captains are linked to a radio network of the same frequency with the radio base in the Municipal building as the center of communication, completing the set-up of our reliable communication system.

It is therefore of utmost necessity that at its early stage of planning, organizing, and recruitment of membership, the Mayor of that town must be informed beforehand, not only to get his approval but to gain his commitment of support. The **PNP PCR PNCO** initiating this must have an excellent rapport with his Mayor as well as those whom he will seek for assistance.

After gaining the commitment of support of the Mayor, we must eventually gain the support of all the Barangay Captains, thus establishing and completing the **KARANCHO COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK**. The Barangay Captain, being the executive Officer of the civil government in the Barangay will be greatly honored when he is invested as the **KARANCHO ZONE COORDINATOR**, more so if he can be persuaded and recruited to join the **KARANCHO** if qualified, for he will automatically be the **KARANCHO ZONE COMMANDER**.

**Our KARANCHO Communication, Coordination and Action System** work this way – Suppose in Barangay Masipag in the Municipality of Maunlad, a robbery is in progress, the Barangay Captain as the **KARANCHO Zone Coordinator or Zone Commander** as the case may be, will right away report the heist by radio to the Chief of Police and to the Municipal Office – the **KARANCHO Central Communication**. And because all the radios of all Barangay Captains of Maunlad are hooked to that same frequency, first hand information of the crime in progress had already been given the widest dissemination that every moment the Barangay Captain of Masipag made his report.

While the **KARANCHO** Chairman and the Chief of Police of Maunlad are making the necessary moves and organizing men and **KARANCHOS** respectively. Barangay Masipag as well as all the **KARANCHOS** of all barangays/zones has already been organized and upon officially receiving the instruction from their Municipal **KARANCHO** main unit, will move to Barangay Masipag in an organized and orderly manner, taking into full consideration that those perpetrators are presumably armed. With the arrival of all the **KARANCHOS** turning barangay Masipag “**BLUE**”, all avenues of escape shall have been made easy by the **KARANCHO** who played the major role in the early solution of the crime by denying the culprits the chance of flight.

Another example is when a **KARANCHO** of Compostela visiting a relative in Kapalong had meet a traffic accident, sustaining an injury. And because **KARANCHO** is almost always first in such kind of mishap because they are now almost everywhere, the **KARANCHO** of Kapalong will then cause the incident to be reported by other **KARANCHO** to the Police and the attending **KARANCHO**, after the police investigation, will conduct the said **KARANCHO** of Compostela to the nearest hospital, summon his other companion to cause to inform Compostela **KARANCHO** Chapter of the said mishap via the said communication network, the **PLECS**, and Compostela **KARANCHO** will immediately inform the relatives of that **KARANCHO** and to plan what that Chapter can do on the premise.

TO : All KARANCHO CHAPTERS

## 1. BACKGROUND:

The most awaited quest to be an organization of credence aiming for the third award for the year 2000 was not favored to the KARANCHO, Inc. Nevertheless, we have to continue our crusade considering that we are not after the merits that we can get but with the good deeds that we can do to our community in particular and the government in general.

Let us accept everything as a challenge to our individual capacity as well as to the entire KARANCHO family that there is still enough room for improvements of which, in many more years to come, we can do our best to put-up a land mark that could not only be engraved in a piece of metal sheet, but to the innermost heart of the people whom we served.

## 2. PURPOSE:

This implan provides a full orientation and guidelines for the establishment of the KARANCHO standard operating procedures nationwide.

### A. Broad Objective:

To support all KARANCHO chapters being challenged to establish a new KARANCHO foundation by their neighboring towns and provinces in order to accomplish its primary function in sowing the seeds of peace and harmony.

### B. Specific Objectives:

1. To attain the Vision, Goal and Mission set forth to its Constitution and By-laws.
2. To gain understanding from among the KARANCHO Chapters in particular and the KARANCHO members nationwide in general.
3. To institutionalize this organization as the venue for reconciliation and peace making Institution.

4. And to be worthy in the community and deserving to the government as a law abiding citizens.
5. Above all, to reinforce the economic stability of the community.

### 3. CONCEPTS:

#### General:

Consistent to the LOI- Police Community Relations Offensive program dated 26, May 1993, the KARANCHO, Inc. where it belongs shall at all times properly coordinate with their local Police Station and the Local Government Units for better cooperation and harmonious relations.

#### Brief Orientation:

The KARANCHO, Inc. was founded on June 12, 1996 by PCSUPT JOSE CRISOSTOMO C. LALISAN, Jr. when he was then the PNP Regional Director of the RPO-XI. It is in compliance to the Implan to LOI Police Community Relations Offensive wherein the objective of which is to develop institutional support of the community to the PNP. He envisions that with the mobile capability of the motorcycle riding community, these persons are potent to be conduit for the "Community Oriented Policing System program" of the PNP whom he tagged latter as "BEST C.O.P.S. ON THE ROAD".

Hence, the KARANCHO, Inc. had become active supporter of the PNP on Community Oriented Policing System activities whose scope of responsibility is to enhance the partnership of the LGU's, NGO's, and the PNP in the pursuit of just and peaceful society nationwide.

By the authority of PCSUPT JOSE C LALISAN, Jr. the Provincial Police Office of Davao Del Norte was chosen as pilot of the said project whose mechanics was engineered by the then SPO4 CARLITO B BARENA of which, after several months of propagating the said project, it was materialized with the concept of Non-Government Organization. A non-partisan, non-sectarian and non-combatant brotherhood organization geared to assist the PNP PCR's Community Assistance and Development programs.

At present, the KARANCHO, Inc. is now a nationwide organization having 140 chapters from different cities and municipalities all over the Philippines with a prestigious standing as the most awarded Non Government Organization proven by its merits and hundreds of commendations.

### 4. CONCEPT OF ADMINISTRATIONS:

#### a. Organizational Structure:

The KARANCHO, Incorporated is a unique organization that adapted the concept of equity to all aspect of privileges and opportunities and upheld the virtues of *Respect One Another*. The creation of its organizational structure had become sensational considering that it was already expanded largely but still upholding the traditional way such as "there shall be no one above the others" and to equalize the status of every chapter, both agreed that there shall be only one Central Office as the overseer with equal footing to all KARANCHO chapters nationwide..... (See Figure 1)

**b. Logo** - the symbolic natural resources and industries of Davao Province with a man riding a motorcycle that goes out from Davao Province heading towards all points in the country to sow the seeds of peace and harmony to all mankind. **Official KARANCHO Logo**

1. Dove - resemblance of peace.
2. Circle - represents the Davao Province where it founded dated 1996 defining its major industry such as rice, coconut, gold and fishing.
3. Durian- the trademark of Mindanao.
4. Motorcycle rider - going out from the Davao Province to all points of the country emphasizing by its track as a KARANCHO man to sow the seeds of peace and welfare.
5. KARANCHO MOTTO - "Respect One Another" (Unity-Humility-Camaraderie-Solidarity-Brotherhood)

#### c. Uniform

3. Sweat shirt color black with logo at the back, patch at the left portion of upper chest



and KARANCHO stripped along the sleeves.

4. Black pants.
5. Black shoes.
6. Black working vest.

**d. Authorized Patches**

7. KARANCHO Patch- emblem of a motorcycle man (ordinary patch of the KARANCHO to be placed at the upper portion of the left chest)
8. Trekker Patch - Emblem of flying Eagle with set of scales on its beak (a special patch to those who have gone to KARANCHO National Affairs to be placed at the upper portion of the left chest)
9. Trekker Patch- Emblem of a flying Eagle with set of scales on its beak surrounded by a set of silver leaf of laurel (to be given to the most highest degree of merit award)

**e. Membership Categories:**

- a. **1st. Membership in Highest Degree of Merit** (silver leaf of laurel and trekker patch to be awarded by the Guest of Honor during National KARANCHO affair to be given to.
  - a. Any public official who had displayed a sincere social services that was truly benefited by the general public.
  - b. While in the course of assistance during fire incident, have had evacuated an abandoned child, disabled person and or unconscious inhabitants within or nearby the vicinity of a burning house.
  - c. During vehicular accident, have had rescued victims who are on eminent danger like for example by initiating a heavy equipment or any special devices to pull out the victim/s beneath the wrecked vehicle.
  - d. On flood disaster, have displayed courageous rescue of victims by his means of which, if not of the said initiative the victim would surely die.
    - i. ( note: any of the above)
  - e. Had served the KARANCHO for at least two years
  - f. Have maintained a good standing category by donating his dues without personal favor and malicious intent to gain
- b. **2nd. Membership in exemplary standing** (Trekker patch to be awarded by the National Office during Regional and Provincial affairs)
  - a. Have extended effort and or assisted/participated in the sowing of seeds of peace and harmony by organizing a new KARANCHO Chapter not least than seven (7) chapters.
  - b. Had upheld justice by testifying in the witness stand on heinous crimes and or assisted the law enforcers leading to the apprehension of the suspect/s.
    - i. ( note: any of the above)
  - c. Have had attended a KARANCHO National activities.
  - d. Have maintained the member in good standing category.
- c. **3rd. Membership in meritorious standing** ( KARANCHO patch with four silver buttons of stars inside to be awarded by the chapter chairman)
  - a. Have had commence an act of brotherhood towards his fellow KARANCHO by acting as a true brother in time of mishap and personal necessities.
  - b. Have had donated his blood to the national red cross
  - c. Have had rescued victims of vehicular accident and facilitated the request to contact the parents, relatives or spouses of the victims.
    - i. ( note: any of the above)

- d. Have received public citations from public officials where he resides.
- e. Have maintained the member in good standing category.

**d. 4th. Membership in good standing** (KARANCHO patch with three silver buttons of stars inside to be awarded by the chapter chairman)

- a. Have been affiliated with the KARANCHO.
- b. Have attended the KARANCHO regular meeting.
- c. Have paid his monthly dues.

**e. 5th. Honorary members** (KARANCHO patch with two silver buttons of stars inside awarded by the chapter Chairman)

- a. Have technically or financially supports the KARANCHO sustainability
- b. Have had provided facilities to the KARANCHO chapter.

**f. 6th. Ordinary members** (KARANCHO patch with one silver button of star inside)

- a. Active in the locality.
- b. Have had participated ten times touring activities of the chapter.

(Note: the first and second award shall be supported with a certified write up and endorsement of the Local Officials and or COP of the PNP in the locality duly supported with letter of authority by the Central Office.)

**g. 7th Courtesy to the Awardees**

- a. Courtesy to the awardees of highest degree of merit - all KARANCHO members shall extend utmost courtesy to any person wearing the said insignia and shall be greeted first before others and must be addressed as "high degree".  
Ex. High Degree Robert Advencula
- b. To the exemplary standing- shall be respected as an honorable person and shall be addressed as "EXE-S". Ex. EXE-S Robert Advincula.

**g. Moral and Welfare**

**1. Awards**

- a. Merits
  - a. To be awarded after thorough evaluation and screening during KARANCHO National Chapter Chairmen's meetings
- b. Silver buttons
  - a. To be determine by the higher government officials or the KARANCHO Central Office
- c. Recognition
  - a. Certificate of recognitions and plaque of appreciation from the public, government agencies and the KARANCHO family

**2. Pre-need Insurance**

- d. Availability of the group insurance privilege.
- e. Availability of voluntary financial assistance

**3. Network Assistance** - All active KARANCHO members shall be assisted

courteously after showing all his credential and updated efficiency card

#### **4. Primary Duties and Responsibilities**

- a. Compulsory duties and responsibilities in case of break down - No one shall leave any KARANCHO members with corresponding KARANCHO identity along the road who are in need of help.
- b. In case of accident - No one shall leave any KARANCHO members who are victim of accident in the hospital without informing his parents, relatives and or spouses.

**5. In case of social conflict** - No one shall inflict injuries to any KARANCHO members except during self- defense.

#### **6. RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

##### **a. Diligence** - Active KARANCHO member

- 1. Shall gave a monthly efficiency card duly signed by the chapter chairman
- 2. Shall not enjoy the network assistance except on time of emergency

##### **b. Greetings Rules**

###### **1. KARANCHO Hail**

- a. Only KARANCHO chairmen, toast master an or designated person can challenge the KARANCHO hail;
- b. It must be done during opening and closing of the program and on special occasions of which the chairman shall determine the necessity in doing so.
- c. This must be treated as a sacred greetings.

###### **2. Hand shaking.**

- a. Every KARANCHO shall extend his/her left hand for hand shaking to every KARANCHO he or she meets.
- b. Hand shaking should be observed with dignity and honor.

###### **3. Hand greetings.**

- a. When riding a motorbike or four-wheeled vehicle, the one who first see the other KARANCHO riding in a motorbike or a four wheeled vehicle must do the hand greetings.
- b. Failure to respond must be avoided in order not to cause ill feeling to KARANCHO brothers.

##### **c. Touring Rules**

- 1. Before moving from any places, the battalion commander shall see to it that all his men are completely on the line
- 2. Never move the troops not unless all are in tacked.
- 3. While at the same time, the rear scout shall give signal after all are ready to move.
- 4. While cruising, everybody must observed the first rule- no over taking unless necessary.
- 5. Gave way to the rear scout while he is overtaking to avoid delay of his message to the battalion commander.
- 6. Hand Signal.
  - a. Thumbs up greeting shall be always the left hand.

- b. Everyone who participates the touring must execute the proper hand signal given by the battalion commander or the touring team leader.
- 7. Light Signal.
  - a. "Lights on" is a must to all KARANCHO members whether in group or in a single travel even on broad day light.
  - b. Shall alert the opposite KARANCHO vehicles upon sighting with his/her light dimmer.
- 8. Parking.
  - a. Park the motorbike or vehicle always in an alert position.
  - b. Always park your bike or vehicle to the designated parking area.
  - c. See to it that parked motorbike is locked.
- 9. Attendance.
  - a. Listing of K-members is a must during touring by the designated Secretary.
  - b. The Battalion Commander is responsible to the safety and security of all KARANCHO during touring.

**d. Rules on Acquisition and Usage K-Paraphernalia**

- 1. Uniform
  - a. Acquisition of Uniform must be supported by an authorization from the K-Chairman.
  - b. Only those who are active and are regular K-members can be issued an authority to acquire of any K-paraphernalia.
  - c. Proper wearing of K- uniform must be observed and shall at all time be monitored by the K-Chapter officers.
  - d. K-Uniform shall be used during monthly meeting, parade, personal travel with EFFICIENCY CARD, and other group activities.
- 2. Tag
  - a. Acquisition of K-Tag shall be approved by the K-Chairman accompanied by a "Note to Acquire" duly signed by the Chairman.
  - b. K-tag shall be worn and boldly displayed by all members for immediate identification.
  - c. Hand shaking shall not be responded to any K- members not wearing K-tag.
- 3. Flag lets
  - a. Acquisition of K-Flag shall be approved by the K-Chairman and shall accompany "Note to acquire" duly signed by the K-Chairman.
  - b. K-flag shall be mounted on the left side of the motorbike or four-wheeled vehicle.
  - c. K-flag shall be rolled when borrowed by non-K-members so as to avoid embarrassment by other K-members.
  - d. Lost k-flag must be replaced and reported to K-Chairman.
- 4. ID – Before an ID shall be issued, the member must:
  - a. Take and pass the K- refresher course exam based from the K-IMPLAN
  - b. After passing the said exam (oral or written), his name will be endorsed by the Chapter Education Committee to the Chairman for the issuance of ID.

- c. Purchase of IDs must be accompanied by "Note to Purchase" from K-Chairman.
- d. ID's must bear the signature of the K-Chairman, City or Municipal Mayor, Chief of Police and the Provincial Adviser.
- e. Lost IDs must be reported immediately to the K-Chairman.

  - viii. KARANCHO grievance revelation - Shall reveal his/her grievances without mentioning the name of the subject.
  - ix. Subsequently, the most ranking KARANCHO shall call the attention of the subject if he is around and call him to stand through his own volition/will. If in case the subject

would not submit himself, by the power vested to the said most ranking KARANCHO OFFICER, he/she shall request the aggrieved party to mention the name of the respondent in a nice manner.

- x. KARANCHO repentance- The subject must stand to explain his side whether he is right or wrong wherein upon submission of himself, he must ask an apology.
- xi. If the subject is forgiven, everybody shall clap their hands to show acceptance of the subject's repentance.
- xii. Conversely, if the respondent could not accept his fault, the body shall be divided to decide whether he/she is guilty or not and a punishment shall be incurred to her/him by an execution of ten times push-up.
